In a star topology, all PoE switches are connected directly to a core switch, forming a central hub, which allows for efficient data transfer and power distribution. The devices like high-capacity transmitters are placed in this layer. A core layer PoE switch is a high-end networking device integral to any advanced network infrastructure, tasked with managing and directing data traffic between various subnets within a Local Area Network (LAN) or across different LANs. That all depends on what you run. A network core switch should probably not need POE functions but end user switches and/or VOIP switches should have that ability. I would also say not in the core, but your. Each layer is served by specialized switches, with the access switch connecting end-user devices, the distribution switch aggregating traffic and enforcing policies, and the core switch acting as the high-speed backbone.
