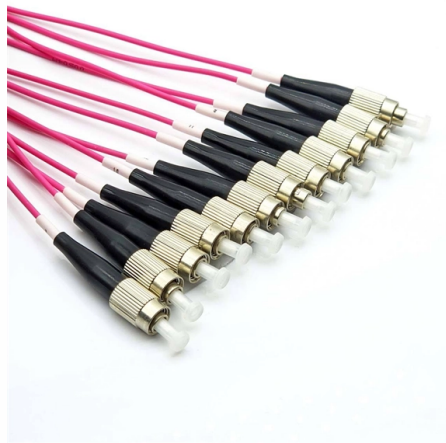


There is an electrical distribution box under the stairs



Overview

The box is usually located in a utility room, garage, under the stairs, or basement. The miniature circuit breakers in the distribution box are designed to protect the electrical system from overloading. Bathroom zones are a number of areas in shower or bathrooms that stipulate the electrical equipment that can be safely installed in that particular area. Description of Zones: Zone 0 is the area within the interior of the bath tub and basin. These boxes sit quietly doing their job, day after day and occasionally they are called into action. It seems like the working space in front of this equipment would be compromised by the stairs. This piece of equipment is also known as a distribution panel, distribution board, and circuit breaker panel. Electrical equipment must have a minimum 30". While not specifically excluded by the National Electrical Code (NEC), there are two code standards that a panel must comply with to be located under a stair: 1) The under-stair space is usually a closet, and a panel cannot be located in a closet near ignitable material [NEC 240.
