

White Bridge Structure in Zimbabwe



Overview

It is a road bridge That connects Zimbabwe to neighbouring South Africa. The bridge was named after British politician and industrialist Alfred Beit who financed a lot of colonial infrastructures and was built in year 1929. ^ "Birchenough Bridge". South African Institution Of Civil. The bridge was constructed in 1905 by The Cleveland Bridge and Engineering company of Middlesbrough, England and designed by Sir Douglas Fox and Partners of London. The landlocked country situated near the Zambezi River is famous for Victoria Falls and adventures such as white water rafting and bungee jumping. Home to faunas such as Rhinos, Hippos and birdlife, Matusadona and Mana Pools. The Otto Beit (Chirundu) Bridge spans the Zambezi River at the Chirundu border post between Zimbabwe and Zambia.
